2017 Community Supported Agriculture

Local Roots is a 17-acre family-operated farm located about 25 miles outside Seattle, in the Snoqualmie River valley. 2017 is our eleventh season farming and offering our popular CSA program. A wide variety of crops thrive in our mild climate and world-class soil and we grow more than 50 different vegetables and herbs. CSA subscribers receive a box of freshly harvested vegetables once a week during the growing season. All produce is grown by us, here on our farm.

Dates: The CSA season begins in early June and lasts until late November. Pickup is on Tuesdays in the late afternoon/evening. Our season is **26 weeks long**, with pickup every week from June through October, every other week in November.

Price: We offer two share sizes: **\$570 for the standard box or \$715 for a large box**. The standard box is suitable for a household of two people who cook at home three to four nights a week. The standard box includes 7-10 items (e.g. 1 head lettuce, 1 bunch kale, 1# carrots) each week. The large box option will typically have one or two additional items and/or larger quantities of staple items like salad greens, potatoes, squash, broccoli and green beans.

Payment: We are not set up for online signups or to take credit cards, but we do accept an assortment of e-pay options, which are usually free for both parties. To sign up paperlessly, email Siri with your preferred pickup location and to confirm payment details. **First (or full) payment is due ASAP**. If paying in two installments, second payment is due June 1st.

Egg Add-On: Goose & Gander Farm is owned by Meredith Molli & Patrick McGlothlin, our friends and neighbors. Goose & Gander Farm hens forage on pasture and eat a certified non-GMO soy & corn-free feed, plus sprouted whole grains, fresh vegetables and leafy greens.

Price: \$180 for dozen/week (20 weeks, June thru Oct.) or \$105 for a half-dozen/week.

Vacation/missed pickups: For pre-planned absences, you may pro-rate your subscription price. Dates must be chosen and confirmed with us prior to the start of the season. We do not offer a refund or credit for missed pickups.

Our Growing Practices: Local Roots uses no synthetic inputs on our farm.
